## Road brining update

The road brining petition received enough signatures to be put on the tax rolls. The issue of putting the cost of road brining of Hardwood Heights and Gillings Road on the tax rolls was brought to the Richland Township monthly meeting October 3, 2005. After two public hearings the special assessment district was formed and taxes assessed on the winter taxes for people owning property on Hardwood Heights west of Henderson Lake Road, Gillings Road west of Hardwood Heights (east end of lake) and Ozelma Dr. (1/2 unit). Assessments are \$10 for a full unit and \$5 per half unit per year.

Thanks to members of HLPOA, especially Dan Daniel, for making this happen. For many years the lake association spent a major portion of the yearly dues for road brining.

## Weed control

The lake weed control project will contine this year. Herbicide treatment is scheduled between May 30 and June 16. This will depend on the weather and early season weed growth. It will be done by Aquatic Services of Goodrich and will consist of spot-treatment of Eurasian milfoil, shoreline contact herbicide and algae control as needed.

Mechanical harvesting of weeds, if needed, is tentatively scheduled for the time frame between July 10 and July 21. This will be done by Professional Lake Management of Alto.
