Other treatments will be based on the findings of our engineering firm, Progressive Eng.

They want to remind everyone the goal is not to eliminate all weeds, but to control nonnative weeds, if left untreated, will take over the lake.

In the past the entire lake has been treated for Eurasian Milfoil and other invasive non-native plants. We are currently in the third year of a four-year program.

In general, the entire lake has been chemically treated every four years to control Milfoil. Progressive Engineering will make a determination if the lake needs treatment in late 2008. If needed, they will start the permit process so invasive weeds can be treated in 2009.

A public meeting will be held in the summer of 2008 to determine if the program will continue from 2009 to 2012. Property owners will be notified of the public meeting by mail in the spring of 2008.
