

Weed control - 2011

The initial lake survey for the year was conducted by Progressive Engineering May 19, 2011. Only a few weed issues were found and they were treated as noted.

There were four algae treatments of the lake during 2011.

June 16 -The first treatment of the lake was completed. There was 1.25 acres of curlyleaf pondweed and 19 acres of nuisance filamentous algae.

The pondweed treatment was along the northeast shore.

June 23 - Another treatment for 2 acres of curlyleaf pondweed and 27 acres of planktonic algae. The pondweed area is in the southwest corner of the lake with the algae



treatment in the populated areas of the lake.

July 21 - The third algae treatment of 27 acres along with one-half acre of curlyleaf pondweed in the southwest corner of the lake.

August 5 - Weed harvesting was completed August 4, photo above. 42 cubic yards of weeds were harvested from 14.5 acres of the lake.

August 17 - The 4th treatment - 24 acres of algae along the populated areas of the lake. Maps of the treatment areas can be seen on the web site at

This was a very good year for the weed control project which was established to control the invasive, non-native Eurasian Milfoil and curlyleaf pondweed. No Milfoil was found and very little pondweed. Some native weeds were starting to return at the end of the summer.
